“You shall also be a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem [a cloth headband, sometimes adorned with jewels, worn by ancient monarchs] in the hand of your God.” – Isaiah 62:3, New King James Version (NKJV)

- Sometimes we feel like we are worth **nothing**...
 - ... but God says we are worth **everything**—and He sent His Son to die on a cross to prove it.

Some challenging questions

Why do we sometimes tend to define ourselves by our failures rather than our successes? By what others say about us rather than what GOD has said in Christ? By the lies and accusations of the devil rather than the truth of God’s Word? What if... we allowed the Word of God to *change* how we see ourselves?
