### Some challenging questions

Do we truly understand how desperately people *need* the Lord? That there is a God-sized hole in the human heart that only the Lord Jesus can fill? Are we ourselves drinking *daily* from the spring of living water that wells up to eternal life (John 4:14) through Bible study or daily devotions, prayer, acts of service, etc., or are we doing so only once in a while, when things get really bad?
